

Introduction- purpose of activity:

An inherent characteristic of all food materials is their perishable nature. Some of the deteriorative changes are accompanied by the production of poisonous agents, while hers result in loss of nutrients and physical loss. The principal causes of food spoilage are the growth of microorganisms and biochemical reactions catalyzed by the naturally occurring enzymes in the foods. The extent of spoilage of food materials depends on various factors like post-harvest handling practices, and temperature, humidity, and duration of storage. In a tropical country like India where the ambient temperatures can be very high in several regions, food preservation assumes greater importance in the context of the nation's food and nutritional security.

Most of the agricultural products intended as human food cannot be used directly without some processing. Processing also imparts convenience, variety and usually adds value to a food material. Therefore, in the rural areas where most of the food crops are produced, food preservation and processing will improve their nutritional status and have the potential for income generation and employment.

Basic principles of food preservation:

Man has practiced food preservation in various forms since time immemorial. In the cold regions, the low temperatures helped to prolong the storage life of perishable foods like fruits and vegetables, meat, and fish. In the hot regions, the solar energy helped to dry these foods to stable products. Salting in the case of fish and vegetables, natural fermentation as in the case of wines and vinegar are other examples of classical methods of food preservation. Many of these techniques have since been practiced and a few newer techniques were introduced subsequently.

Food preservation encompasses two major areas viz. preservation (storage) of the fresh produce and preservation by methods resulting in some modification to the fresh form (processing).

1. Preservation (Storage) of fresh produce

Fresh commodities, especially fruits and vegetables must be preserved due to their seasonal availability and highly perishable nature. A number of techniques are followed for preserving them.

- a) Treatment with anti-transpirants:
- b) Pre-Packaging
- c) Low Temperature Storage

2. Preservation of processed food product:

Several techniques are practiced preserving food products. Some of the simple techniques are described below.

- a) Preservation by adding sugar.
- b) Preservation by salt.
- c) Sun drying and dehydration.
- d) Preservation by using chemical preservatives.
- I. Sulphur dioxide and its sodium and potassium salts (e.g., Potassium / Sodium metabisulphite)
- II. Benzoic acid
- e) Preservation using heat.
- f) Preservation by hurdle technique.

PROCESSING: Quality control and food standards always go together and play a vital role in supplying clean, good and standard quality food products to the consumers. In the broader sense, quality control may be defined as the maintenance of the quality and composition at the levels and the tolerances acceptable to the buyer while minimizing the cost of production as far as possible. Food standards are the body of rules directly concerning the foodstuffs. These standards may be:

- a) Officials
- b) Semi- officials (Voluntary)
- c) Factory norms

Food standards required:

- a) To prevent the transmission or the cause of disease
- b) To limit the scale of unfair products.
- c) To simplify marketing of food.

In India, FSSAI (Food Safety and Standards Authority of India) government of India is enforcing the quality control of different types of food products.
