The following broad areas were covered in the Student Satisfaction Survey:



Research Methodology:


A student satisfaction survey as required by the NAAC for AQAR purpose was circulated to all the students of all disciplines under UG & PG programs offered by the college. With the combined efforts of teachers and student coordinators, the survey received 531 responses in total. The survey was initiated via Google Forms in a multiple-choice question format. The form covered four major areas which foreground concerns such as Academic and Teaching, College Administration, and Extracurricular Activities (Webinar, committee programs).

Overall satisfaction seems to be high with 41.6% very satisfied, 45.21% satisfied, and only 3.0 % not satisfied with the overall teaching-learning process provided in the college. The overall performance can be interpreted as a positive response in this direction.


How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 531 responses



How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? for the classes?




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 531 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 531 responses




The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth




 The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow 531 responses




Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programe outcomes.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you 531 responses




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications 531 responses




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them 531 responses




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. 531 responses




Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.


18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

Action Taken Report:

- In the year 2022-2023, the total number of students(UG+PG) enrolled in the college is 1184) In total 456 responses were received from the students.
- The collected sample pool was carefully studied by the IQAC committee in Feb-2024.
- In the same month, a meeting was arranged with the principal Dr. Ch. Rajalingam to reflect on the survey and seek suggestions for further improvements.
- In the meeting, IQAC members presented a report for the survey to have a detailed analysis of the survey.
- The Librarian of the college was requested to be a part of the meeting to discuss the feedback regarding the library and its resources. It was noted that despite the best efforts by the library staff, students were not aware of the excellent resource pool offered by the library. All in all, the inputs collected were taken into consideration to improve the overall learning experience for students.

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
