This Memorandum of understanding (MOU) is signed on 25.11.2019

AMONG:

A.V.College of Arts Science and Commerce located at Gaganmahal, Hyderabad, hereinafter referred to as "A.V.College" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include his executors, authorized representatives, administrators, successors-in-interest and permitted assigns) of the First Party.

AND

Waste Ventures India Pvt. Ltdan existing company within the meaning of the Companies Act, 1956 having its office at, Survey 301 and 317, Behind KJR weigh bridge, Bachupally Road, Bachupally 500090, represented through its Director Mr. Roshan Miranda, hereinafter called "WVI" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its executors, authorized representatives, administrators, successors-in-interest and permitted assigns) of the Second Party

WVI has established partnerships with environmentally sustainable recyclers (including e-waste) for various types of waste. Recycling partners of WVI are compliant with the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Municipal Solid Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016 to convert various high and low value recyclable material in to recycled material of same type (in case of plastics and paper) or to other useful materials such as composite board and/or roofing sheets for Tetra Pak laminate materials.

Whereas A.V.College, has agreed to give away various types of dry waste generated including, paper based materials, various plastics and other materials as described in section 1. The collection of dry recyclables from First Party will be initiated by Second Party as per their schedule, agreed mutually by both the parties.

**NOW THIS SERVICE AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER:**

This SERVICE AGREEMENT is intended to create a synergic alliance between A.V.College & WVI for the recycling of various recyclable materials, which otherwise may end up in dumping grounds or may get processed by illicit recyclers who may recycle materials in an environmentally irresponsible way. Environmental processing of recyclable waste is one of the vital elements in the protection of environment.

**1. DEFINITIONS**

- 1.1 **Wastepaper:** Discarded paper including cardboard, newspaper and magazines, shredded papers, old office records, etc.
- 1.2 **Plastic and other waste:**
  - 1.2.1 **Regular plastic waste items:** Water bottles, PET bottles, polythene sheets, carry bags, beverage cans/containers
  - 1.2.2 **Miscellaneous plastic waste items:** Includes broken plastic items not obtained on a regular basis
- 1.3 **Multi-laminate Tetra Pak and metalized plastic material:** Multilayered packing material containing aluminum, plastic and paper in layers that is used to pack beverages, juices, milk, snacks, biscuits etc.
- 1.4 **Glass waste:** Includes glass containers such as bottles, jars and other glass waste such as glass panes etc. all in unbroken condition.
- 1.5 **Metal Waste:** Metal waste: Includes Iron, Aluminum, etc.
- 1.6 **Designated Day:** A day in the week / fortnight/month agreed between parties.

### 3. QUALITY & MINIMUM QUANTITY OF MATERIAL

3.1 Material should be dry and free from any leftover beverages, food particles, without any contamination of garbage, municipal waste or any item which are detrimental to recycling of the materials.

3.2 Minimum required quantity for pick up: 250 Kgs.

### 4. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF FIRST PARTY

4.1 A.V.Collegewill identify the quantum of different recyclable materials generated at various locations.

4.2 A.V.Collegewill store all recyclable materials and WVIwillpick up on mutually agreed schedule.

4.3 FIRST PARTYagrees to appoint\*-----as its authorisedrepresentative to coordinate on various activities identified in MOU and to notify WVIwithin one month of any change in responsibility.

4.4A.V.Collegewill allocate for itself sufficient covered storage space for keeping the material safely and dry.

4.5 A sale invoice in the name of Waste Ventures India Pvt.Ltd. willbe issued by First party with local VAT (prevailing rate 5%) to enable faster payment. Invoice will be sent by post/ courier to the address given in this MOU within two days from the date of collection of material along with the copies of weighment slips. Copy of the same can be scanned and sent to [roshan@wasteventures.com](mailto:roshan@wasteventures.com) for processing, if an online exchange is preferred..

4.6Payment will be processed within two weeks from the date of receipt of the invoice along with gate pass and weighment slip.

### 5. REPRESENTATION AND WARRANTIES

5.1 WVIrepresents and warrants that:

7.1 Service Provider agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless **FIRST PARTY**, his representatives, and agents from and against any and all claims, actions, demands, legal proceedings, liabilities, damages, losses, judgments, authorized settlements, costs or expenses, including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any alleged or actual:

- (i) Infringement of copyright, patent, trademark, trade name, trade secret or other proprietary or intellectual property right of any third party by the Services, Deliverable(s) and/or any materials delivered under this Agreement;
- (ii) Breach of any warranties including implied warranties contained in this Agreement by **WVI**;
- (iv) Any violation by **service provider** of any governmental laws, rules, ordinances, or regulations;
- (v) Breach of confidentiality and/or data privacy obligations under this Agreement, by **WVI** and/or;
- (vi) Claim that **WVI** is not an independent contractor.

## 8. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

8.1 In no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party or any other person or entity for any special, exemplary, indirect, incidental, consequential or punitive damages of any kind or nature whatsoever (including, without limitation, lost revenues, profits, savings or business, or contribution or indemnity in respect of any claim against the party) even if such Party has been informed in advance of the possibility of such damages or such damages could have been reasonably foreseen by such Party.

8.2 **A.V.College** liability to the **WVI** arising out of or in connection with this Agreement regardless of the form or nature of the action giving rise to such liability (whether in contract, tort or otherwise) and including any and all liability and any damages shall not exceed, in the aggregate, the total fees paid by **WVI** to **A.V.College** for the Services properly performed for a twelve (12) months period immediately preceding the date on which such liability arose.

## 9. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

**WVI** acknowledges that it is acting as an independent contractor, the **WVI** is solely responsible for its actions or inactions, and that nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create an agency or employment relationship between **A.V.College** and **WVI** or its representatives. **WVI** is not authorized to enter into contracts or agreements

on behalf of A.V.College or its customers to third parties. The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that if any workers or personnel engaged by WVI and provide services on-site at A.V.College customer and/or A.V.College locations shall be employees of WVI and not of A.V.College or any of its subsidiaries for all purposes, including workers' compensation, taxes, compensation and employee benefits. WVI agrees that they shall be solely responsible for payment of all applicable workers' compensation, disability benefits, employee benefits and unemployment insurance, and for withholding and paying such employment taxes and income withholding taxes as required.

## 10. AMENDMENT

Any modification to this Agreement shall be effective only if it is signed by both Parties.

## 11. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be contrary to law, such provisions shall be severed from this Agreement and the other remaining provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

## 12. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF WVI

5.1 WVI shall pay to A.V.College through bank transfer or check or in equal worth of stationary materials or other recycled end products for the following materials. Prices paid to **FIRST PARTY** for various materials are mentioned below:

- **Wastepaper:** A sum of Rupees Four Thousand (Rs.4,000) per Metric Ton
- **Mixed Dry Waste:** A sum of Rupees Five Hundred (Rs.500/-) per Metric Ton
- **Plastic:**
  - **Regular plastic waste items:** (Water bottles, PET bottles, polythene sheets, carry bags, beverage cans/containers ): A sum of Rupees Two Thousand (Rs.2,000/-) per Metric Ton
  - **Other Solid Plastic waste:** A sum of Rupees Six Thousand (Rs. 6,000/-) per Metric Ton
- **Multi-laminate Tetra Pak and metallized plastic material:** A sum of Rupees Two Thousand (Rs.2,000) per Metric Ton
- **Glass waste :** A sum of Rupees Five Hundred (Rs.500/-) per Metric Ton for regular glass and no payment for tempered glass

- **E-Waste:** The prices of E-Waste are listed in the appendix.
- **Metal Waste:**
  - A sum of Rupees Seven Thousand (Rs.7,000/-) per Metric Ton for Mixed metal..
  - A sum of Rupees Seventy eight Thousand(Rs.78,000/-) per Metric Ton for Aluminum

Materials are assumed to meet all quality standards as mentioned in section 3 to qualify for these prices. Applicable GST of 5% on plastic and paper items and applicable GST on other items will be paid.

**5.2** WVI will provide a certificate for paper and plastic products including Tetra Pak materials that specifies that WVI supplied materials equivalent to or more than the amount picked from A.V.College for recycling through certified recyclers and those materials were recycled per regulatory compliance.

**5.3** WVI will make necessary arrangements for collecting and transporting of the materials mentioned.

### **13. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN GENERAL**

**6.1** The details laid out in this MOU, notwithstanding the essence and spirit of this MOU is an understanding between A.V.College and WVI.

**6.2** Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be sent by way of e-mail or through Registered Post Acknowledgement Due (RPAD) to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out in this contract or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other.

**6.3** WVI will issue quarterly sustainability report to A.V.College indicating the quantity of individual scrap material recycled and the achieved impact in terms of number of trees saved and CO<sub>2</sub> averted from dump yards. As you may be aware, waste is a major contributor of Green House Gases. Additionally, one ton of paper or Multi-laminate Tetra Pak and metalized plastic material recycled can save 17 fully grown trees & 7000 gallons of water.

### **14. INFORMATION SECURITY CONTROLS**

a) WVI shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations and standards and shall further support A.V.College by agreeing to comply with any laws and regulations that are applicable to A.V.College and FIRST PARTY' Clients at all times.

b) WVI or the respective FIRST PARTY department shall create appropriate awareness amongst Supplier personnel about securely handling FIRST PARTY Information as part of working in A.V.College premises.

c) FIRST PARTY or FIRST PARTY appointed 3rd party agency shall have the rights to perform an audit of the WVI and the WVI services provided to A.V.College. d) All Services shall be performed only by WVI personnel. WVI shall not assign or subcontract to another agent or subcontractor any of the Services or part of the

Services to be performed without the express prior written consent of an authorized officer of **FIRST PARTY**. In case **WVI** further assigns or subcontracts services to another agent or subcontractor, then **WVI** would be responsible to contractually extend all security controls mandated by **FIRST PARTY** to the hired agent or subcontractor.

e) **WVI** personnel who are part of this category shall not be granted logical access to any information on **FIRST PARTY** systems.

The concerned department of **A.V.College** will ensure that **WVI** personnel are allowed to access **FIRST PARTY** systems strictly on need to know and least privilege basis. The departments allowing such access to supplier personnel shall inform the Supplier personnel to follow the Clear Screen and Clear Desk policy and any other applicable **A.V.College** Policy.

- i) The departments availing services from Supplier personnel who have access to buildings and work areas shall ensure that the following controls are communicated to the Supplier staff.

#### **WVISHALL:**

1. Wear and use one's own company or **A.V.College** provisioned ID badge at all times within the **A.V.College** Campus and furnish the same at any instance when asked by **FIRST PARTY** security officials.
2. Operate only from the designated area.
3. Declare the items carried inside /outside **A.V.College** in the Physical Security register.
4. Stay alert and report any suspicious activity/incidents to the nearest **FIRST PARTY** Security Official or employee.
5. Be prepared for impromptu audit by **FIRST PARTY** authorities.
6. Use the prescribed gates to enter and exit the **A.V.College** premises.

#### **WVISHALL NOT:**

1. Tailgate into any areas including Offshore Development Centers (ODC's) or other restricted areas.
2. Disclose any **FIRST PARTY** confidential information
3. Attempt to enter any restricted areas like Server rooms, Offshore Development Centers (ODC's) or other restricted areas unless required to do so for business needs.
4. Carry out any photography/video shooting in **FIRST PARTY** premises.
5. Carry any printed information lying unattended at **FIRST PARTY** work area out of **A.V.College** premises.

6. Bring or attempt to bring any weapons inside **FIRST PARTY** premises.

## **15. ANTI- SEXUAL HARASSMENT POLICY**

WVI and its personnel, while performing Services throughout the term of this Agreement, needs to adhere to **A.V.College's** Anti Sexual Harassment Policy as illustrated herein below:

(i) WVI understands that **A.V.College** is committed to providing a work environment free of unlawful harassment and prohibits sexual harassment in any and all forms, and acknowledges that it has received a copy of the **A.V.College'** Policy on Prevention and Redressal of Sexual Harassment ("**FIRST PARTY Policy**").

(ii) WVI acknowledges and understands that solely for the purpose of the sexual Harassment of women at workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 ("**SH Act**") and the **A.V.College SH Policy**, the workers or personnel of WVI who are providing services to **A.V.College** would be deemed as employees of **A.V.College**, if any such worker or personnel is employed and / or performs any service under this Agreement at **A.V.College** workplace ("**Employees**").

(iii) WVI covenants that it shall comply with the requirements of the SH Act and also with **A.V.College SH Policy** and ensure that all Employees are made aware of the **A.V.College SH Policy** and provided a copy of the same upon the commencement of provision of Services to **FIRST PARTY**.

(iii) WVI covenants that it will constitute its own internal complaints committee ("**ICC**") as per the SH Act and will investigate any sexual harassment complaint against or reported by its employees or any such sexual harassment incidents brought to its notice by **A.V.College** involving employees of WVI.

(iv) If a sexual harassment complaint is being investigated by **A.V.College ICC** (involving employee(s) of WVI), WVI acknowledges that it shall extend all necessary support to **A.V.College ICC** including implementing any interim measures that **A.V.College ICC** may recommend to WVI. Further, upon completion of inquiry by **A.V.College ICC**, WVI acknowledges that it shall implement the final recommendations of **A.V.College ICC** in the manner prescribed in the recommendation.

**17.1** A confirmation by both the parties that no benefit, either in cash or kind has been provided by either party to the other party or to any officer or employee, or any relative/ associate of any officer or employee of either party or of any of their associate institutions/companies in order to enter into this Agreement, and

**18.1** Force Majeure: Neither party shall be liable for damages for any delay or failure to perform its obligations here under, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party including without limitation, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earth quakes, explosions, acts of God or state or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of any Governmental body.

**18.2** Entry into Force and Duration: This Agreement comes into force from 25.11.2019 either party may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

**18.3** Any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be settled amicably between the parties. This Agreement is subjected to the Jurisdiction of Courts at Hyderabad/ Secunderabad.

18.4A.V.College' security has the right to check/ investigate the vehicle transporting recyclable materials (including carry bags).


18.5 The Parties covenant that they will comply with all applicable laws and regulations in their conduct pursuant to this Agreement.




